Poor education standards and limited exposure to the outside world leaves most Myanmar people vulnerable to the fast paced change and the many peculiarities of globalisation. Myanmar is a conservative, largely Buddhist society, which is already facing major pressures to perform quickly in order to pick itself up. Access to excellent education is an essential first step.

The International Leadership Academy (ILA) was established three years ago by New Zealander, Neil Macintyre and American, Richard Dare, to provide world class education in business, leadership and English language acquisition. The Nay Pyi Taw campus was opened November 2016 and currently has 280 English language students across four streams, 26 MBA students and the BBA programme commenced January 2018. The MBA currently has 16 students from the private sector and 10 senior ranked Government officials. ILA also provides leadership training and consulting services to the top echelon of a number of Myanmar Government Ministries.
